Greenwich Hospital – Year in Review

Megan Katz of Darien will always remember St. Patrick's Day 2022 as the glorious day when Dylan – born at 27 weeks of gestation – finally came home after 63 days in Greenwich Hospital's Level III-B Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. The newborn's journey demonstrates the high-level of care available at Greenwich Hospital through its affiliation with Yale New Haven Health, one of the nation's premier healthcare systems. "Our family is full of gratitude," said Katz.

The Katz family were among the thousands of Connecticut and New York residents who turned to Greenwich Hospital in 2022 for preeminent healthcare services. A total of 3,089 newborns were born at the hospital. Inpatient discharges reached 13,444 for the year, with outpatient encounters at 400,968. The Emergency Department saw 38,769 visits.

Clinical innovation

While the number of hospitalized COVID-19 patients never reached pandemic proportions, the virus and its numerous variants remained a community threat. Thousands of adults and children – including a growing number with advanced illnesses because they delayed care during the pandemic – sought inpatient and outpatient medical and surgical services.

Greenwich Hospital adeptly tackled these challenges, providing high-quality care with the finest doctors, nurses and other healthcare providers, bolstered by the collaboration with Yale New Haven Health, Yale Medicine and Smilow Cancer Hospital.

With a focus on its most vulnerable patients, Greenwich Hospital was certified by the American College of Emergency Physicians as a Level III Geriatric Emergency Department to provide specialized emergency care to patients ages 65 and older. To better serve children and adolescents, Greenwich began construction of the Pediatric Ambulatory Surgery Center.

The Smilow Cancer Hospital Care Center in Greenwich provided innovative lung cancer screening with low-dose CT scans to potentially increase survival rates. Several Yale Cancer Center physicians joined the Smilow team in Greenwich, further expanding the scope of surgical, medical and radiation oncology services available to area patients.

Greenwich Hospital – Year in Review

The greatest of care

As part of Yale New Haven Health, Greenwich Hospital trained future generations of physicians and nurses through its Internal Medicine Residency Program, Perioperative Nurse Residency Program and Susan D. Flynn Oncology Nursing Fellowship Program. Additional Yale Medicine physicians joined Greenwich Hospital and its outpatient facilities at West Putnam Medical Center in Greenwich and Long Ridge Medical Center in Stamford, thereby increasing patient access to care.

Leading the hospital's initiatives were thousands of doctors, nurses, clinicians, non-clinical staff and volunteers – the people who comprise the heart of Greenwich Hospital. Known for their compassion as well as their skills, many of these individuals earned accolades in 2022 from organizations such as the United Health Fund and Gilda's Club of Westchester. A total of 133 Greenwich Hospital-affiliated physicians were selected as Connecticut Magazine's 2022 Top Doctors. Three nurses received the prestigious international DAISY Award for providing exemplary care. A total of 116 hospital employees were nominated for providing an exceptional patient experience.

Helping employees to attain life-work balance was a top priority. Greenwich Hospital established Easy Care, an onsite health clinic for employees, and Self-Care Days for employees, which offered meditation. A pilot program focusing on spirituality and nursing promoted staff well-being and improved retention, while enhancing patient care. Clinical nurse transition coaches supported graduating nurses as they assumed their professional roles.

Building healthy communities

Greenwich Hospital's medical staff and employees looked beyond the hospital's borders to build healthy communities. They donated 4,000 pounds of food in the #GiveHealthy food drive to assist two food pantries, Neighbor to Neighbor in Greenwich and Meals of Main Street in Port Chester, NY. Led by the hospital's Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Belonging Council, they donated 3,240 diapers to local social service organizations to assist families in need and provided home repairs to a Vietnam War veteran through House of Heroes in Connecticut. Employees also served as workplace mentors to Project Search interns from Abilis, which assists individuals with special needs.

As part of ongoing efforts to be environmentally responsible, Greenwich Hospital partnered with Food Rescue to reduce waste and food insecurity by donating unused leftovers to Community Centers Inc. of Greenwich, a local social service agency. The hospital recovered 80,800 pounds of food scraps, which is the equivalent of avoiding 49,288 pounds of carbon monoxide and 56,188 miles of driving. Greenwich Hospital's composting initiative also significantly reduced the amount of waste going into landfills. In keeping with its mission, Community Health offered various educational programs in partnership with local agencies such as the Greenwich and Rye YMCA, Greenwich YWCA, Carver Center, Boys & Girls Club, Greenwich Library and Port Chester-Rye Brook Public Library, Greenwich CT and Westchester, NY schools, and local police and fire departments. Healthcare professionals conducted numerous lectures and webinars for the community. The hospital offered support groups to assist patients coping with multiple sclerosis, cardiovascular disease, Parkinson's disease, chronic pain, cancer and other medical conditions.

Greenwich Hospital also completed its triennial Community Health Needs Assessment and developed a Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP). CHIP guides the hospital's work for the next three years to support the identified health and well-being needs of the community, including improving access to care, increasing behavioral health services, and tackling disparities that impact an individual's health status. The assessment was a community-wide undertaking with extensive data collection and input from area residents, health and social services experts, and people who serve the community every day. Greenwich Hospital conducted the assessment in collaboration with the Greenwich Community Health Improvement Partnership and the Council of Community Services that serves Port Chester, Rye and Rye Brook in New York.

A generous community

The community generously supported the hospital in many ways, including philanthropy and volunteerism. The Greenwich Hospital Auxiliary donated \$350,000 for an adolescent behavioral health program and \$200,000 for the hospital's midwifery program. It also funded four annual scholarships for high school graduates pursing healthcare careers. A total of 220 volunteers provided more than 24,000 hours of service to the hospital despite COVID-19 restrictions.

Gifts to the Greenwich Hospital Office of Development exceeded \$9.9 million from more than 1,177 donors through restricted major gifts and the annual fund. All investments ensure enhanced programming, equipment acquisition and staff education to attain the hospital's future vision. Community support included funding for adolescent and adult behavioral health alongside investments for Neuroscience, Heart and Vascular, Pediatrics, Oncology and the Emergency Department. These programs are all part of the hospital's Comprehensive Campaign that will celebrate a public launch on Sept. 22, 2023 at the annual Benefit.

One of the most poignant moments of 2022 was the unveiling of a beautiful appreciation mural created by artist Rick Garcia in honor of the frontline heroes who worked at Greenwich Hospital during the height of the pandemic and sponsored by C. Parker Gallery. Hundreds of area residents signed the mural during the annual Greenwich Reindeer Festival & Santa's Workshop, that was proudly displayed in the hospital's Carl and Dorothy Bennet Community Garden. The mural reaffirms that Greenwich Hospital, with the support of its community partners, can rise to any challenge – now and in the future.

A national leader in health care

From stroke to diabetes care to oncology and outpatient services, Greenwich Hospital's culture of excellence and exemplary patient experience drew national recognition in 2022, including:

- A five-star hospital quality rating from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services – the highest distinction offered by the federal agency – two years in a row.
- Three Press Ganey Guardian of Excellence Awards for patient experience in Inpatient, Outpatient Oncology and Outpatient Rehabilitation, and three Pinnacle of Excellence Awards for exhibiting the highest patient experience standards for three consecutive years.
- An "A" grade as one of the safest hospitals in the nation, according to The Leapfrog Group, an independent national patient safety watchdog group.

- The Women's Choice Awards as one of America's Best Hospital's for Patient Experience and Cancer Care.
- An award for providing the latest evidence-based stroke and diabetes care from the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association.
- A three-year reaccreditation of Smilow Cancer Hospital Care Center in Greenwich from the Commission on Cancer and the National Accreditation Program for Breast Centers.
- American Nurses Credentialing Center recognition of Yale New Haven Health's Nurse Residency Program offered at Greenwich Hospital.
- Designation as a LGBTQ+ Healthcare Equity Top Performer in the Human Rights Campaign Foundation's Healthcare Equity Index.

Expert pediatric care in the community

Meghan Katz was looking forward to Dylan coming home after two months in Greenwich Hospital's Level III-B Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU). Yet she felt a trace of sadness about leaving the neonatologists, pediatric specialists, nurses, speech therapist, occupational therapist and physical therapist who helped Dylan – born at 27 weeks of gestation – thrive when he was the most vulnerable.

"The NICU staff became part of my family," said Katz, who has three boys under the age of 3. "It was amazing to have such a great team close to home."

Like Katz, a growing number of lower Fairfield County parents recognize that everything their child needs from a top-ranked children's hospital is at Greenwich Hospital. With its long tradition of providing exceptional pediatric care, Greenwich Hospital has an extensive partnership with Yale New Haven Children's Hospital (YNHCH) and Yale Medicine to enhance its continuum of pediatric inpatient, emergency medicine, surgical and specialty ambulatory care. Plans are also underway to open a Pediatric Ambulatory Surgery Center.

Coverage is available around the clock at Greenwich Hospital with Yale Medicine pediatric hospitalists in the inpatient unit and YNHCH pediatric emergency medicine physicians in the Emergency Department. Located at 500 West Putnam Ave. in Greenwich, just a few miles from the New York border, the YNHCH Pediatric Specialty Center in Greenwich has nationally ranked specialties and expert providers. Telehealth capabilities also allow families and providers to easily consult with specialists.

"Parents have peace of mind with the added level of support and expertise that our pediatric specialists and subspecialists bring to Greenwich Hospital," said Karen Santucci, MD, chief medical officer and a board-certified pediatric emergency medicine physician. "Pediatric specialists have specific training and experience diagnosing and treating infants, children and teens. They know how to establish an instant rapport with kids, providing assurances they're in a safe, friendly place. They also collaborate with community pediatricians to ensure continuity of care for each patient." "The NICU staff became part of my family. It was amazing to have such a great team close to home."

"Our clinical training helps us navigate the nuances and subtleties of caring for children and teens. We work with the family and the child to home in on exactly what's going on," said Seth Woolf, MD, a Yale Medicine pediatric emergency medicine physician. Nearly 25 percent of the roughly 40,000 patients treated in the ED each year are children and adolescents. A separate pediatric waiting room – featuring a virtual fish tank, child-size furniture, age-appropriate books, TV programming and interactive media – helps to make a child's visit less stressful. Kid-friendly decor makes the examination rooms more inviting.

Rabia Malik, MD, is a pediatric hospitalist in the inpatient Pediatric unit. "Pediatric specialists need to be versatile because each age comes with its own challenges," she said. "The unit's nurturing environment address the needs of children, who may have difficultly expressing themselves, as well as those of parents, who may be concerned. Parents and guardians help us to make informed decisions."

Katz appreciated the NICU's family centered care. "Everyone at Greenwich was so welcoming and approachable," she said. "I had direct access to the doctors and nurses. They were always available. They were truly invested in Dylan's care."

"A large part of what we do is take care of the entire family," said Shruti Gupta, MD, a Yale Medicine neonatologist and the NICU's medical director. "We focus on how to best increase the quality of life of the babies and their families."

Where the beat goes on

Jill Ernst's first cardiac episode occurred nine years ago during the birth of her triplets. Her physician advised her to see a cardiologist. But Ernst attributed the heart issue to the stress of delivering three babies by cesarean section, so she did not visit the heart specialist.

Her second cardiac event in December 2019 was more alarming. Ernst was in a barre class when she sensed her heart racing. "I had this overwhelming, light-headed feeling, as if I was going to faint," she recalled. "It was the first time I had experienced something like that." At a walk-in clinic, an electrocardiogram (EKG) registered her heart rate in the 180s, far above the normal resting rate. "They assured me, though, that I wasn't having a heart attack."

Still, they recommended Ernst, then 43 years old, take an ambulance to Greenwich Hospital's Emergency Department, where the cardiologist on duty administered another EKG and a chest X-ray, neither of which indicated any heart disorders. He did prescribe medication.

On the advice of her primary care provider, Ernst saw Ilir Maraj, MD, a Yale Medicine electrophysiologist at Greenwich Hospital's Yale New Haven Health Heart and Vascular Center at 500 West Putnam Ave. in Greenwich. After several tests, Dr. Maraj determined Ernst had supraventricular tachycardia (SVT), a malformation involving the heart's electrical system. SVT is an abnormally erratic heartbeat – often called an arrhythmia – that occurs when the normal electrical impulses in the heart are disrupted. Symptoms include shortness of breath, chest pain, fatigue, light-headedness, dizziness and palpitations.

"The heart is a mechanical pump," said Dr. Maraj. "However, it has a natural pacemaker that generates electrical signals to the four chambers through specialized fibers, and that's how the heart beats." He advised Ernst to continue taking the medication and wear a heart monitor to track any recurring arrhythmias. Erst experienced another arrhythmia while teaching a yoga class, prompting Dr Maraj to suggest she undergo an ablation. "It was convenient to have the ablation at the hospital and my follow up appointments with Dr. Maraj at the Heart and Vascular Center. Everything I needed was close to home."

"During an ablation, we insert thin flexible tubes, called catheters, through the veins on both sides of the groin," explained Dr. Maraj. "Using electrical sensors on the tips of the catheters, we trigger the same arrhythmia. We then apply radiofrequency energy or heat to eliminate the abnormal heart tissue emitting the irregular electrical signal. This procedure restores a normal heartbeat."

Dr. Maraj scheduled Ernst's ablation at Yale New Haven Hospital in March 2020, "but then COVID-19 hit," she said, and the hospital suspended many non-urgent surgeries. When she finally had the procedure, the delay proved fortuitous because Greenwich Hospital was performing ablations at its Electrophysiology Laboratory by then. That meant the Greenwich resident could access advanced treatment without a long commute to New Haven.

"I spent the night in the hospital and went home the next day. It was convenient to have the ablation at the hospital and my follow up appointments with Dr. Maraj at the Heart and Vascular Center," said Ernst. "Everything I needed was close to home."

"I have my energy back and do not take any medications," added Ernst. "I'm also more conscious about pushing myself too hard. Now after yoga, I take a few minutes to cool down and make sure my heart rate hasn't gone up. It feels great to be back to teaching yoga again."
